Benefits of connection between Christians and missionaries

Timothy was a model of selflessly looking out for the interests of others, able to show genuine concern for the Philippian Christians. (Ref.: Philippians 2:4)

Will you serve people, for the sake of Christ?

Seeking (devoting serious effort to) own interests, or Christ's

A proven servant

Will you make yourself qualified to serve the Lord as a leader? (Read 1 Timothy 3:1-13)

Be a person who can be relied upon.

Doing ministry together can foster significant relationships.

Need of partnership in ministry

If you're a leader, try to always have a partner in ministry. If you are a servant, offer your partnership to a leader.
