All provision is from the Lord. (ref.: Deut. 8:17-18)

4:11-12 Learning to be content in whatever

Contentment is an attitude, an outlook on life, that is independent of external circumstances, specifically financial circumstances.

From what Paul had learned, he knew how to be with humble means and with abundance.

Who we are in Christ should define us, and be the basis for our joy.

Content is different than being satisfied with having needs met. (ref.: 1 Tim. 6:8)

Contentment is needed even when living with abundance.

Who we are in Christ should define us.

Are you content in Christ, no matter what your financial circumstances?

4:13 Capable of all this in Christ, who strengthens

The most valuable thing I have is I'm in Christ.

Contentment should affect the way we use resources.

Debt (see Prov. 22:7)

Giving (ref.: 2 Cor. 9:6-12, see Eph. 4:28)

Contentment should affect how we get money.
